## Progress Report of RSPG SG Long-term vision for the upper 6 GHz band

Since the last RSPG Plenary meeting, the Subgroup met three times for virtual sessions (27.3. & 12.4. & 17.5) and worked on the draft Opinion with the participation of representatives from numerous countries:

1. Meeting: AT, DE, EL, ES, FR, HU, IT, LIE, LU, MNG, MT, NL, PT, SE, SI, UA, FI, IE, CZ, PL, CY, DK and the European Commission & ECO;

2. Meeting: NL, MT, PL, EL, SE, DE, LU, PT, NO, AT, IT, MNG, FR, BE, FI, UA, ES, DK, SI, BE, IE, CZ, PL and the European Commission & ECO;

3. Meeting: NL, MT, PL, SE, DE, PT, AT, MNG, EL, FR, HU, FI, DK, LU, SI, ES, SE, LIE, IT, CZ and the European Commission & ECO.

The focus of the first session was on the structure of the report. The following meetings were concentrating on the scope of the opinion, followed by the usage of the band, the current usage and protection requirements, possible development and an overall assessment.

In the upcoming meeting (next meeting is planned on the 2.9.2024) we want to discuss the role of the upper 6 GHz for MFCN and RLAN before and beyond 2030.
