Progress Report of the RSPG Subgroup

Long-term vision for the upper 6 GHz band

Progress Report of RSPG SG Long-term vision for the upper 6 GHz band

Since the RSPG#67 plenary meeting held on 17 June 2025, the Subgroup has met 3 times in web sessions on: 7.10., 10.10., 24.10.2025. Representatives from numerous countries are participating in the work activities of the group: AT, BE, CY, CZ, DE, DK, EL, ES, FI, FR, HR, HU, IE, IT, LIE, LU, MNG, MT, NL, NO, PL, PT, SE, SI, TR, UA, and the European Commission & ECO. On the first meeting the results summary of presentation and excel sheet were presented by the co-chairs and was for the last meeting put in the right format. On the last meeting the group decided not to provide the Annexes with the public consultation summary due to the lack of time.

After analysing the contributions to the public consultation of the Opinion, the RSPG identified two main preferable options for the policy recommendation on a band split with prioritisation within the upper 6 GHz band:

1. 0 MHz – entire upper 6 GHz band for a prioritised use for full power MFCN (Annex 1)
2. 160MHz – prioritised band split in the upper 6GHz band, the lower 160 MHz to WAS/RLAN and the upper part to MFCN. (Annex 2)

Both options include adequate protection requirements for the incumbent services. These options are to be considered for discussion during the RSPG Plenary in November 2025, where a decision will be made to select one of the two.
