**19th Progress Report of the RSPG Sub-group
on Peer review and Member State cooperation
on authorisations and awards**

The RSPG at its Meeting #57 (online, 9th February 2022) approved the 18th Progress Report of the RSPG Sub-Group on Peer Review and Member State cooperation on authorisations and awards.

I. PEER REVIEW FORUM

Since last RSPG Plenary there were no requests for the Peer Review Forum on the basis on Article 35 of the European Electronic Communications Code.

During this period of time only Lithuania notified the Radio Spectrum Policy Group about undertakings for selection procedure in the frequency range 3400-3700 MHz dedicated for wireless broadband electronic communications networks and services. However, Lithuania did not request the Radio Spectrum Policy Group to convene a Peer Review Forum for the 3400-3700 MHz frequency band on the basis on Article 35 of the European Electronic Communications Code.

II. WORKING GROUP MEETING

On April 12th, the Working Group discussed the organisation issues of the Stakeholder Workshop. The Group took in consideration conclusions of the public consultation on the RSPG Programme with regard to the Peer Review, leaving the scope of the topics to the decision of the Stakeholders. Based on the results, the Group sent on May 12 via the RSPG Secretariat an invitation to the Stakeholders with the request of proposal for topics of interest along with the skeleton of the Agenda.

III. STAKEHOLDER WORKSHOP

The Stakeholder Workshop is scheduled on June 20th. Depending on the replies received, from topics that will be the most popular and appear most often, the Group will choose four and then invite particular entities to participate in a role of a presenter.

It was explicitly indicated that the the proposed topics cannot cover areas of interest of another Working Groups of the RSPG, i.e. WRC-23, UHF, etc.
