
Results of the 3rd RSPG Questionnaire Good offices - 700 MHz band *Cross-border coordination issues*

October 2017

Evolution vs 2nd questionnaire

- All EU countries have responded, three of them indicating no evolution from the previous responses (DE, BE, LU). Five non EU countries have responded: MK, NO, TU, RS, ME
- Planned end of migration date exceeding 2020 only for IT and LT(2022). CZ and MT are now 2020 and 2019, respectively
- End of migration not yet specified for PT, LV, SK, CY
 - LV: understanding is that the difficulty is related to cross-border negotiation with Russia (ie same as LT or PL).
 - SK: understanding is that this is related to the fact that broadcasting licences are lasting until 2028 and negotiation with broadcasters has not yet been completed
 - PT: understanding is that this is related to the fact that broadcasting licences are lasting until 2022 and negotiation with broadcasters has not yet been completed
 - CY: no timetable yet, but trying to be within the relevant EU timeframe. Efforts are focused in securing frequencies below 700MHz, through frequency coordination with neighbouring countries outside EU
- Authorization date after 2020 only for HR and SI, but many countries have not yet specified the date
- Coordination progress in several coordination clusters, including Adriatic, SEDDIF or with Russia and Belarus.
- Cyprus has officially requested EU assistance regarding coordination with Turkey. Italy has officially requested EU assistance regarding coordination with Albania and Algeria.
- Possibly other need for EU assistance with countries outside Europe: Russia, Tunisia, Libya.




Q1 plan for migration
