**I. PEER REVIEW FORUM**

Since the last RSPG Plenary the Working Group has not received any request to convey a voluntary Peer Review Forum on the basis of Article 35 of the European Electronic Communications Code (EECC).

**II. NOTIFICATIONS**

The Working Group has received one notification by Member States without the request for conveying a Peer Review Forum.

**Latvia** – 3<sup>rd</sup> of January 2024 on a selection procedure in order to assign the rights of use of spectrum bands 1734.80 MHz – 1735.20 MHz / 1829.80 MHz – 1830.20 MHz and 1759.80 MHz – 1760.00 MHz / 1854.80 MHz – 1855.00 MHz.

**III. SUB-GROUP MEETING**

On January 15<sup>th</sup> sub-group conveyed the meeting in order to discuss issues raised by several Stakeholders during the public consultation on the Work Programme 2024 and beyond on the improvement of the Peer Review deliverables.
