**23rd Progress Report of the RSPG Sub-group
on Peer Review and Member State cooperation
on authorisations and awards**

The RSPG at its Meeting #61 (hybrid, 14th June 2023) approved the 22nd Progress Report of the RSPG Sub-Group on Peer Review and Member State cooperation on authorisations and awards.

I. PEER REVIEW FORUM

Since the last RSPG Plenary the Working Group received two requests from Slovak Republic and Austria to convey a voluntary Peer Review Forum on the basis of Article 35 of the European Electronic Communications Code (EECC).

The Peer Review Forum requested by Slovak Republic was held virtually on 14th September and focused on aspects on selection procedure in order to reassign frequencies from frequency band 900 MHz and 2100 MHz for wireless broadband electronic communications networks and services. The meeting was attended by 45 participants from 20 Member States and European Commission.

The Peer Review Forum requested by Austria was held virtually on 2nd October and focused on the discussion regarding selection procedure in order to assign radio spectrum in 3600 MHz (remaining frequencies) and the 26 GHz band for wireless electronic communications networks. The meeting was attended by 53 participants from 22 Member States and the European Commission.

II. NOTIFICATIONS

The Working Group has received one notification by Member States without the request for conveying a Peer Review Forum.

- **Latvia** – 1st September - on the expiration of the procedure to assign the rights of use of spectrum band 3750-3800 MHz.
